Ajay K. Chaubey (Ph.D.), formerly a Senior Assistant Professor of English & Head at the Department of Humanities & Social Sciences, National Institute of Technology, Uttarakhand, is an **Associate Professor & Head, Department of English, Jananayak Chandrashekhhar University, Ballia (Uttar Pradesh) since April 2022**. He has published majorly on *V S Naipaul* (Atlantic, 2015); *Salman Rushdie* (Atlantic, 2016) followed by a trilogy on *South Asian Diaspora*, published by Rawat Publications, Jaipur in 2018, 2019 & 2020. He has presented his papers in more than fifty national/international conferences held in India and abroad. Dr. Chaubey has visited Nottingham Trent University, Nottingham; the University of Leicester and York St. John University, York (United Kingdom) during June 2014, and presented his papers on V S Naipaul and Dalit Literary discourses in India. He has to his credit more than forty publications which appeared in national and international journals, magazines, and anthologies, the few of which are indexed in the UGC-CARE and the SCOPUS and Web of Sciences. His recently published volume is *Gandhi Across Disciplines: New Millennial Responses* (co-edited).

In addition to the above, Dr Chaubey has delivered many expert lectures and plenaries in webinars, workshops, conferences and symposia. He has also chaired technical sessions in the conferences organized in IIT-Indore; Mahishadal Raj College (W.B.), in academic association with State University of Milan, Italy, and IIT-Roorkee, etc. Additionally, he has organized seminars, conferences, workshops, FDP's and STTP's in academic association with MNIT, Jaipur, IIT-Roorkee, The Indian Econometric Society, New Delhi and NIT, Trichy, etc.

He has been the first In-charge Dean and Associate Dean (Student Welfare) at the NIT, Uttarakhand. He is on the advisory/editorial boards of various national/international journals, including *The Journal of English as an International Language* [ISSN: 2200-2014 (Online)], indexed in the SCOPUS, published by English Language Education Journals, Australia. He has guest edited *LITERARIA: An International Journal of New Literatures Across the World* (ISSN: 2229-4600) for the Special Issue on Literature of the India Diaspora, Vol. 3. 1 (Jan-Jun 2013), published by Bahri Publications, New Delhi, India.

Dr Chaubey has been conferred upon with the **Letter of Appreciation**, for his outstanding services in the Institute, by the **Director, National Institute of Technology, Uttarakhand** on the auspicious occasion of the **Independence Day in 2020**.

Currently, Dr Chaubey is a Principal Investigator of a Project on "Tourism Development in Ballia" funded by the Department of Higher Education, Government of Uttar Pradesh.
